

furncloud history

Background:

All furnplan users having activated furncloud will find the new button "furncloud history" in the top left corner of furnplan, see figure 1. The activation of furncloud can be managed from the Administration_FV.

Please note:

From version 2018.9.0 onwards, the button 'Show/hide catalogue' has been moved to the right side (figure 2).

Creation of the furncloud ID:

Whenever the user clicks on "Print" (figure 3) or "Tot. Price" (figure 4), or when the user is rendering the planning with furnray (figure 5). The planning is uploaded to the cloud.

You can also use the button 'Save current planning in the cloud' (see figure 6) directly under the 'furncloud history' function and label the generated ID.

Each uploaded planning is linked to a new furncloud ID.

Please note: The furncloud ID remains connected to the planning. Using the furncloud ID, you can access the corresponding planning at any time. The possibilities to generate this furncloud ID are shown below.

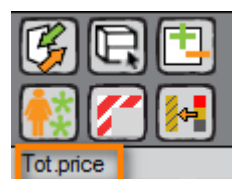

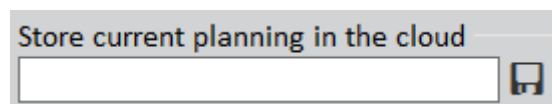

Application:

While furncloud automatically stores all plannings in the cloud, furncloud history gives an overview of all of the stored plannings.

As soon as furncloud history is clicked,  a window appears on the right hand side as shown in figure 7.

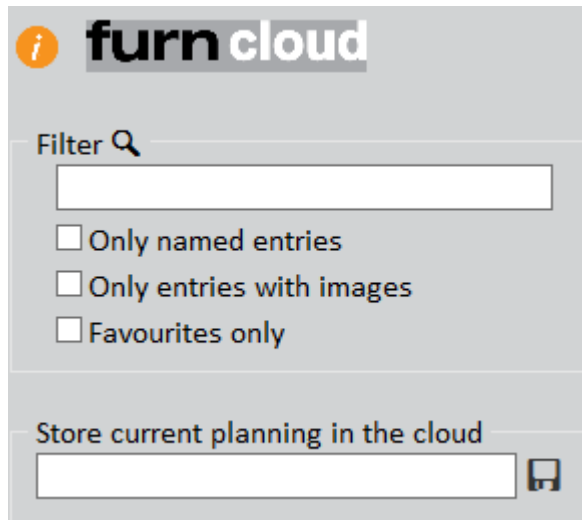

2. If a furncloud ID has been created for the planning (see 'Creating a furncloud ID'), it will be shown in the overview (figure 8, furncloud ID1).

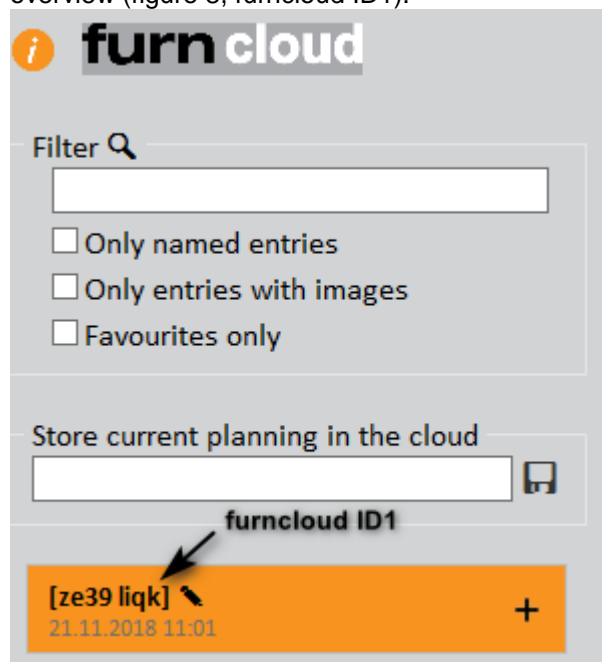

- After changing parts of the planning, it can be saved again in the cloud (furncloud ID2). This newer version is shown directly below the previous version (furncloud ID1). The new furncloud ID (furncloud ID2) is shown in orange (figure 9).

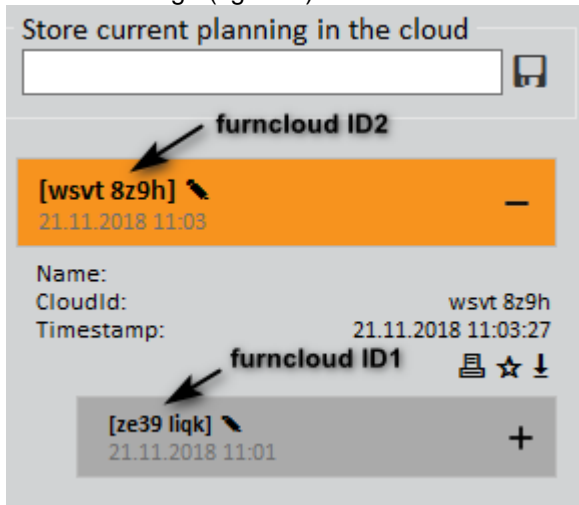

- The planning previously stored in the cloud (furncloud ID1) can be selected and changed at any time by simply clicking on the corresponding furncloud ID (furncloud ID1). You can switch back to the latest version at any time. Click on the download symbol under the furncloud ID (furncloud ID1). The furncloud ID2 is retained and you can access the second cached planning at any time.

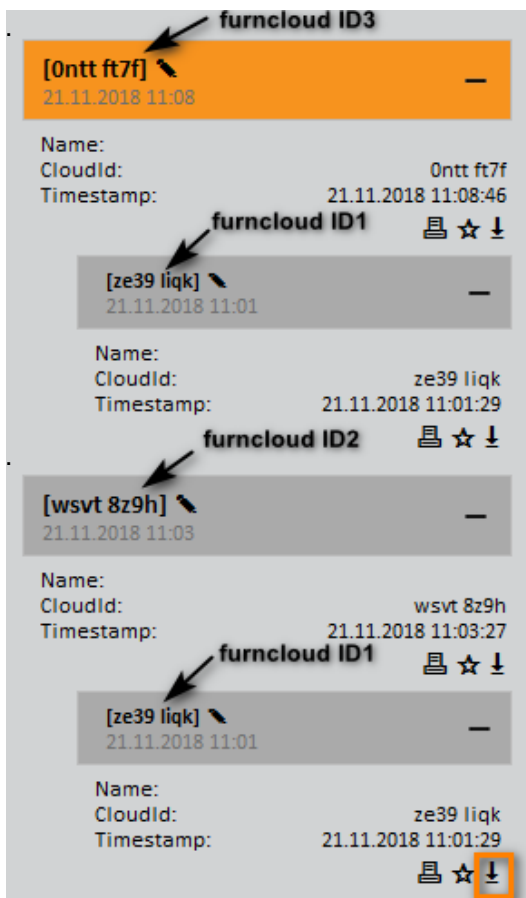

Please note: If you have already made changes to the second planning (furncloudID2), it is of course advisable to create a different furncloud ID beforehand to ensure the changes are not lost. To load another furncloud ID, click on the 'Download' icon in figure 10. Let's assume you have loaded furncloud ID1 again and that you take this as a basis for further planning. By generating a furncloud ID again, furncloud ID3 is created. From the list you can clearly see that furncloud ID3 is created from furncloud ID1.

In a nutshell:

By using the furncloud ID's you can continue working in parallel with all of the planning. You can have access to every planning for which an ID has been generated.

Extended functionality:

1. A Descriptions can be linked to the furncloud ID's, which improves the overview. The description can be entered or modified by clicking on the pen icon in figure 11 and enter a new name for the furncloud ID (here: Finished Planning 1).
The original furncloud ID remains the same.
By clicking on the +, the details of the planning, such as the furncloud ID, become visible.
If you are using the furncloud in other application areas, the original furncloud ID should be used and **not** its label.

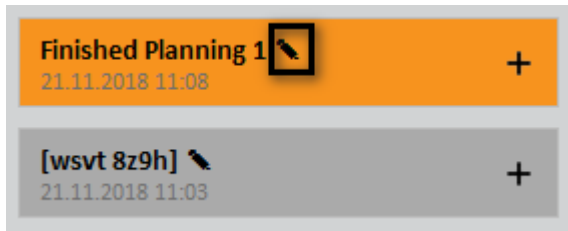

2. A planning/furncloud ID can be tagged as favorite by clicking the star below the ID, as shown in figure 12.

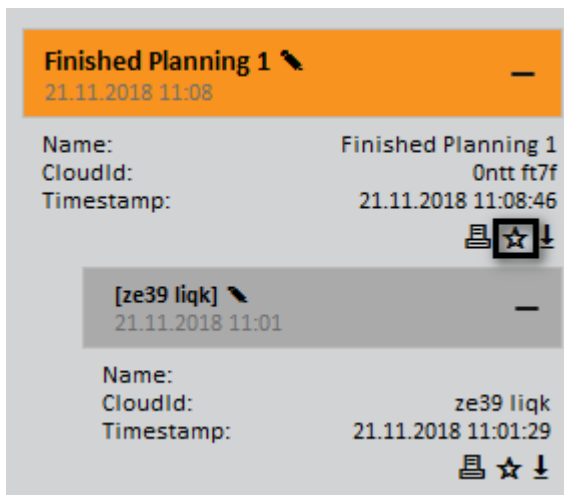

3. To further simplify its use, furncloud historie offers you the possibility to search specifically for both labels and furncloud IDs.

Optional:

If you have labeled a furncloud ID as described in 1, you can filter the search results by selecting 'Only entries with names'.

If you have marked an item as a favorite as described in 2, you can filter the search results by selecting 'Favorites only'.

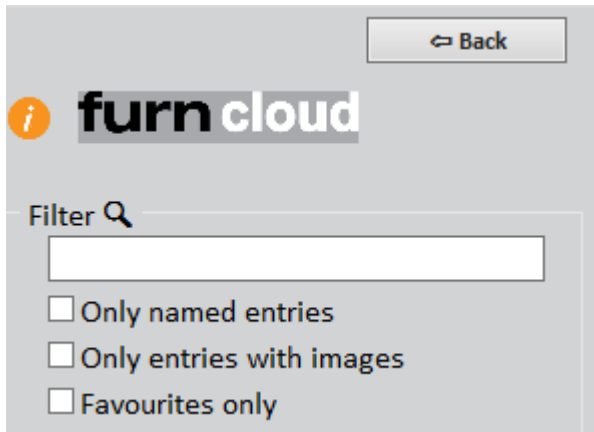

4. The small symbol under the furncloud ID shows what triggered the creation of the furncloud ID. The 'printer' stands for generating when printing. The 'camera' stands for generated while rendering.

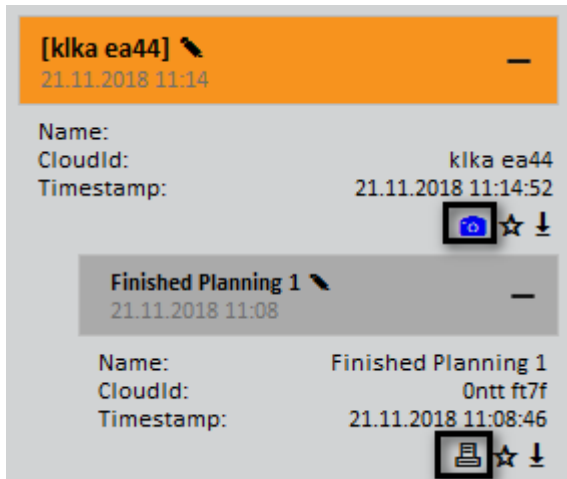

Furncloud history and furnray

If you use furnray to render your planning, furncloud history is a useful tool to monitor the status of your render order. When your planning is uploaded with furnray, the button furncloud history shows the different stages of the rendering process.

From this, the following can be observed:

a) **Blue**



The planning is queued.

b) **Red**



The planning is being rendered.

c) **Green**



The planning is rendered and the image is ready. By clicking on the camera icon, the rendered image can be opened directly in furnplan (see figure 15). In addition, you will receive the photo by e-mail.

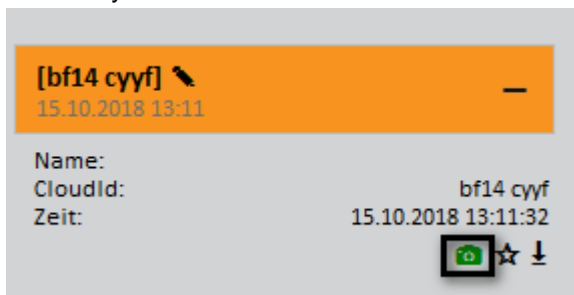

d) **Yellow**



You already have one or more rendered images. Others are still queued.
